All Facility Services student jobs are advertised on OSCAR (Online Student Career And Recruitment) at <http://careers.mcmaster.ca> however students **must** meet criteria requirements set out under McMaster's Student Work Programs: McWork (summer employment) and the Ontario Work Study Program (fall/winter employment).
